Minister's Corner

AT LAST - LIGHT AT THE DOOR

May is named after the Greek goddess Maia who cared for plants. This month is known for the beauty of flowers, love and success. I'm guessing many of us are grateful that the dark, cold Covid winter is behind us. In March of 2020 when we felt compelled to close the doors of First Unity for the first time, someone asked me how long I thought we would be pre-recording services. I vividly remember my answer,

"You cannot hold on to the old while declaring that you want something new. The old will defy the new. The old will deny the new. The old will decry the new. There is only one way to bring in the new. You must make room for it."

The hallway experience ends first in consciousness. The door that opens to our future good is the door of our minds,

"Oh probably for a few weeks." The idea that the pandemic might last over a year was something I could not even imagine. Nor could I anticipate the changes it would bring to our lives.

Researchers & theologians alike tell us that the change and transition process has three stages: an ending or loss; the void; & finally a new beginning. In the book Hell in the Hallway: Light at the Door, Rev. Ellen Debenport calls the mid-stage "the hallway," that period of intense uncertainty, when life as we knew it has ended, but what comes next is still a mystery." I believe those of us who are blessed to have survived this pandemic will be forever shaped by the experience. There are so many things over which we had no control in our 14-month hallway, and yet "hell" is a state of consciousness. For many, this hallway experience has been a time of personal reflection and spiritual growth. Knowing that God is omnipresent, we have understood that even in the midst of chaos, darkness, and pain, God and Goodness are there.

And we are so ready to open the Door to the light of new beginnings in our personal lives, our communities, and our beloved spiritual center. However, before we embrace those new beginnings, we might have to release anything that holds us back. Father Richard Rohr begins his book Eager to Love, with these words from Neale Donald Walsch,

attitudes, and convictions. This means we acknowledge and accept what has happened these past 14 months. Life has changed. It's time let go of fear, anxiety, and old habits that no longer serve us. It's time trust our inner light and cultivate patience. It takes as long as it takes! It's time to bless and focus on the gifts of the hallway in order to open the door to new beginnings. At First Unity, thanks to the vision of the Board of Trustees and the generous support of so many of you, we used this Hallway time to completely upgrade our sound system, improve the lighting, and install a large screen where state-of-the art visuals will be clearly projected throughout the sanctuary. Our Sunday services will be livestreamed in real time and available thereafter for people all over the world to join us. A new screen and projector in the Community Room will have the capacity to simultaneously project the entire service downstairs when additional seating is needed. The flooring project has been completed throughout the building, and there will be a few other surprises. All of these innovations are part of our spiritual community's new beginning, enabling us to reach out beyond our four walls to serve a greater community, thereby helping to celebrate our vision of a world awakened to infinite possibilities and to accomplish our mission to enrich and transform more lives through prayer, education, and service. There is light at the door!



PUTTING THE POWERS TOGETHER

In her book *Divine Audacity*, Rev. Linda Martella-Whitsett defines "divine audacity" as "fearless overcoming of only-human tendencies in order to do, or say, that which unifies, harmonizes, strengthens, or uplifts. With divine audacity, you dare to be the light of the world." Each power is inherent. We all come into this world like a fully loaded hard drive equipped with the 12 powers. However, it is up to us to recognize and develop them in spiritual consciousness. Charles Fillmore used the archaic word "quicken" which meant to *kindle*; to cause to burn more fiercely; to come alive. Activating our spiritual powers is a choice and a practice. Each power or special ability is important by itself, but they are all aspects of the One Power. Used together, they become amazing tools for us to live in freedom and joy.



The 12 Powers

Unity Co-Founder Charles Fillmore defined twelve fundamental powers of the Christ that compose our Divine Nature. It is part of our soul's evolution to awaken and utilize these powers, also called *faculties*, *gifts*, *abilities*, *attitudes*, *qualities*, and *freedoms*. Mr. Fillmore associated each power of the mind with one of Jesus' disciples, and he also correlated the powers with corresponding locations or nerve centers in the physical body. Later, colors were added to correspond to each power. Understanding these powers is the first step in activating them to enrich our lives.

Building on the work of Charles Fillmore as well as Julian Jaynes, Teilhard de Chardin, and Buckminster Fuller, Rev. Phillip presents the twelve powers as dyads in the chart.

Fillmore Festival August 19–22, 2021


The Fillmore Festival will be held in person at the Village. This is an interesting exploration of the Fillmore Legacy & practical metaphysics.
